Underwear, appropriate	6
Shorts, athletic/PT navy blue	1
Sleepwear - sweatpants and sweatshirt recommended	1
Swim Suit, navy blue (Female must be 1 piece)	1
Shower Shoes	1 pr
Bath Towels	2
Wash Cloths	2
Personal Hygiene Kit (Soap, soap holder, shaving gear, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb/brush, shampoo, deodorant, body/foot powder, contact lens solution, etc.) [NO aerosol cans or glass containers]	1

Notes:

1. Cadets traveling via commercial transport will travel in civilian attire. You will have the opportunity to change upon reporting to the billeting site.
2. A cloth carry bag (a day bag) is highly recommended. These are cloth bags that you can roll up and stow in a minimum space.
